<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	MANDATORY These are the required college courses that must be taken and completed before the deadline to apply and a minimum grade of a C is required.

	The applicant must have a minimum college GPA of a 2.5.
	The applicant with a GED certificate must have a 50 overall score with a score of 50 on all sections.
	If the GED scores do not meet the requirements listed above, then the applicant must have a college cumulative GPA of 3.0.

	Score of 18 is required.
	If an applicant has a score of 15 – 17, then they must have a college GPA of 3.0 or higher.
	The ACT is not required if the applicant has a BS degree in any subject with a minimum final cumulative GPA of 2.5; however, the score will be added to the final point system.
	Cannot be older than 10 years.

	Three reference letters from individuals other than family are required.
	These letters are to be postmarked or received no later than May 31st for you to be eligible for consideration into our program.
	Letters can be mailed, faxed or emailed.

This is your chance to see what a Radiologic Technologist does throughout the day. You will be notified when it is time to schedule this visit.
