Application Requirements

Falsification of any information on the application will result in dismissal of your application.

Due to the restrictions of class size, *application to the program does not guarantee acceptance*. Acceptance is a very competitive process. Just because you meet the minimum standards this does not guarantee acceptance. We are currently accepting 20 students.

DON'T MISS THE DEADLINE!

Deadline for application is May 20, 2022 for the 2022 – 2023 school year. Deadline for turning in required documentation is May 31, 2022.

<u>Requirement checklist – please read carefully!</u> Must be 18 years of age prior to the program's start date in September. \checkmark Transcripts High school transcripts with GPA and ACT scores noted **on transcript** are **required** unless you have a BS degree. An applicant with a GED certificate must have a 50 overall score with a score of 50 on all sections. If the GED scores do not meet these requirements, then the applicant must have a college cumulative GPA of 3.0. College transcripts. MANDATORY required college courses that must be taken and completed with a minimum grade of a C. We prefer for all courses to be completed by deadline however; if you must take a class later, you will have until the 1st week of August to have final grades sent. Due to this being after interviews, acceptance is contingent on a passing grade. Intermediate College Algebra or College Algebra Fundamentals of Public Speaking or Oral Communication (Must be a 3 hour class) **English Composition I** If A & P courses are successfully passed on 1st attempt, an additional point Anatomy & Physiology I will be awarded on the applicant's interview grade point sheet. Anatomy & Physiology II Grade points: A = 4 points, B = 3 points and C = 1 point. \checkmark **GPA** The applicant **must** have a **minimum** cumulative college GPA of a 2.5. GPA must be noted on all transcripts. \checkmark ACT score Composite score of 18 is required. If an applicant has a score of less than 18; then they must have a cumulative college GPA of 3.0 or higher. The ACT is not required if the applicant has a BS degree in any subject with a minimum final cumulative GPA of 2.5. ACT score **cannot** be older than 10 years. We only accept the National ACT. In accordance with ACT, the residual ACT is only for the school it was taken for. We do not require the writing portion of the ACT. \checkmark **Reference letters** Three reference letters from individuals other than family are required. The letters can be mailed, faxed or emailed. All three letters must be postmarked or received no later than May 31st. 8-hour observation visit – subject to change based on visitation rules An observation visit is where the applicant will be toured to some of the clinical educational sites where training will occur. This is your chance to see what a Radiologic Technologist does throughout the day. You will be notified by the School Agent when it is time to schedule. These visits are only done after your application has been received. Interview V An interview will be scheduled for all applicants who have completed requirements by the deadline. This is scheduled by the School Agent and you will be notified by email. Interviews are only held once and are in late June. Background check and pre-employment physical \checkmark If accepted, applicant must pass a background check and complete the DCH pre-employment physical prior to school start date in September. This will be scheduled by and through DCH. Acceptance notification \checkmark Due to background checks and possible delay in final grades; we reserve the right to a 3 – 4 week delay from interview to notification.
