Application Requirements

Falsification of any information on the application will result in dismissal of your application.

Due to the restrictions of class size, <u>application to the program does not guarantee acceptance</u>. Acceptance is a very competitive process. Just because you meet the minimum standards does not guarantee acceptance. We are currently accepting 20 students.

DON'T MISS THE DEADLINE!

Deadline for application is May 20, 2022 for the 2022 – 2023 school year. Deadline for turning in required documentation is May 31, 2022.

Requirement checklist: Must be 18 years of age prior to the program's start date in September. Transcripts with GPA noted. V High school transcripts with GPA and ACT scores noted. The applicant with a GED certificate must have a 50 overall score with a score of 50 on all sections. If the GED scores do not meet these requirements, then the applicant must have a college cumulative GPA of 3.0. College transcripts. MANDATORY - These are the required college courses that must be taken and completed with a V minimum grade of a C. Intermediate College Algebra or College Algebra Fundamentals of Public Speaking or Oral Communication (Must be a 3 hour class) **English Composition I** Anatomy & Physiology I Anatomy & Physiology II **GPA** The applicant must have a minimum college GPA of a 2.5 GPA must be noted on all transcripts V **ACT** score We require a composite score of 18. If an applicant has a score of less than 18; then they must have a college GPA of 3.0 or higher. The ACT is **not** required if the applicant has a BS degree in any subject with a minimum final cumulative GPA of 2.5; however, the score will be added to the final point system. Cannot be older than 10 years. We only accept the National ACT. In accordance with ACT, the residual ACT is only for the school it was taken for. V **Reference letters** Three reference letters from individuals other than family are required. The letters can be mailed, faxed or emailed. These letters are to be postmarked or received no later than May 31st. 8-hour observation visit – *subject to change* An observation visit is where the applicant will be toured to some of the clinical educational sites where V training will occur. This is your chance to see what a Radiologic Technologist does throughout the day. You will be notified by the School Agent when it is time to schedule. Interview An interview will be scheduled for all applicants who have completed requirements by the deadline. This is scheduled by the School Agent and you will be notified by email. Interviews are only held once and are usually in late June. If accepted, applicant must complete the DCH Regional Medical Center pre-employment physical V examination prior to school start date. This will be scheduled by and through DCH.
